The goal of the Kiwanis Pediatric Emergency Medicine Fellowship is simple: *Save and improve the lives of children by training doctors in the latest pediatric treatment.*

In 2007, Dr. Andrea Thorp completed the Kiwanis Pediatric Emergency Medicine (PEM) Fellowship at Loma Linda University Hospital and became our first Kiwanis Doctor. She and her colleague Dr. Tim Young, our second Kiwanis Doctor, each treat more than 3,500 children annually, and, to date, have trained more than 1,000 first responders throughout our District.

Dr. Thorp currently serves as the Assistant Program Director for the PEM Fellowship at Loma Linda University and is directing the medical aspects of the Kiwanis Doctor Program. She continues to lead seminars throughout our District and looks forward to mentoring the next generation of pediatric emergency physicians.
