

# 2011-2012 District Inter-club Competition Guidelines

An inter-club meeting is one which is held by two or more Kiwanis clubs or by a Kiwanis club and any of their sponsored organizations. Clubs with membership of 20 or less must be represented by a minimum of two members, clubs with membership between 21 and 30 members must be represented by a minimum of three members, and clubs with 31 or more members must be represented by a minimum of four members. The attendance by each of the members must be for at least 60% of the function time. (From Kiwanis International's Policies & Procedures)

1. Your club may receive inter-club credit on your monthly report form if the required number of members attend a/an:
  - Division Council Meeting (hosted by a Kiwanis Club)
  - Governor's Official Visit
  - International President's Visit
  - Mid-Year Conference Inter-club Luncheon
  - International Convention Inter-club meal function(s)
  - District Convention Inter-club meal function(s)
  - Service Leadership Program (SLP) Club Meeting

When any of the above meetings are at a division, District or International level, you must still attend the host club's regular meeting to receive credit for the Round Robin competition.

2. To qualify for an inter-club, the visiting inter-club must be present for at least 60% of the host club's meeting.
3. A Lt. Governor may not be counted as a member of your inter-club unless the Lt. Governor is a member of your club.
4. If a member is dropped before the end of the administrative year, that member is not required to attend an inter-club in order to compete for an inter-club award. If a new member joins your club in September, the club is not required to have that member participate in an inter-club that month.
5. Inter-club credit will be given only with the host Kiwanis family club, irrespective of the number of clubs attending that function (e.g., if there are inter-clubs from three different clubs present at the same function hosted by a Kiwanis club, each of the three clubs will receive an inter-club only with the host club).
6. A Kiwanis club can only earn one inter-club credit for attendance at the same event (i.e.: if there are 12 members from one Kiwanis club attending the same event, there is one inter-club).
7. Winners will be judged on total points earned, based on the criteria listed on the competition report form.

An alternative District contest will be the mileage contest. **A club may enter only one of the two inter-club contests** and must make the selection before they submit their entry form for either contest. A Kiwanis club will earn inter-club mileage credit for each inter-club which they attend during the Kiwanis year, based upon the driving distance one-way between their club meeting place and the place of the inter-club, multiplied by the total number of members attending the inter-club. Kiwanis members of all categories as well as members of SLP clubs sponsored by your Kiwanis club will count as members for the purpose of this contest. The mileage credit will not depend upon the mode of transportation; it is to be computed by the most direct route. Complete and submit the Inter-club Mileage Contest Form if your club wishes to compete in this contest. (Either form may be used to apply for the Round Robin/Super Round Robin Awards).

District inter-clubbing awards (both points-based and mileage-based) will be presented for first place and honorable mention in three categories: small clubs of 20 members or less; medium clubs of 21 - 30 members and large clubs of 31 members and above, determined by the membership as of July 31, 2012.

The District office does not keep track of your inter-club record. The club secretary must complete the appropriate award/contest form(s) and send to the District Inter-club Chairman.

# Rules for Round Robin and Super Round Robin Awards for the 2011-2012 Kiwanis Year

## Round Robin

1. Inter-club with every Kiwanis club in your division. If your division has fewer than twelve clubs, you must have a minimum of twelve inter-clubs. All division inter-clubs must be at the host club's regular meeting. Division Council Meeting inter-clubs will not be counted toward a Round Robin Award.
2. Inter-club with a Service Leadership Program (SLP) club (Circle K, Key Club, KIWIN'S, Builders Club, Aktion Club or K-Kids Club) whether your club sponsors one or not.
3. Have at least one inter-club in each of ten months during the Kiwanis administrative year (October 1, 2011 - September 30, 2012).
4. Participate in an inter-club outside of your division.
5. Inter-club at the Governor's Official Visit to any division.

All criteria (other than the Governor's Official Visit) must be separate activities and none may be counted more than once.

## Super Round Robin

1. Satisfy the requirements of the Round Robin.
2. 100% of all club members (active, privileged and senior) must attend at least one inter-club (except club members who join the club in September 2012 or who ceased to be club members prior to September 30, 2012).
3. All division inter-clubs must be at the host club's regular meeting. Division Council Meeting inter-clubs will not be counted toward a Super Round Robin Award.
4. Inter-club at either Mid-Year Conference or an Annual Convention (District or International).

*Please note*, because of the membership requirement, only clubs in good standing are eligible for a Super Round Robin.
