SPECIAL OLYMPICS MATCHING FUNDS PROGRAM

The K-Team has established the Matching Funds Program to assist Kiwanis Clubs and Divisions in the CalNevHa District in financing Special Olympics projects that exceed their own resources. Generally, these funds would be for FIRST TIME PROGRAMS in a Club or Division and can be matched up to \$500.

Applications may be made at any time. There are no formal application forms. The application should be typed and in narrative style with enough detail to describe the project. The Selection Committee will consider all applications based upon the following criteria, which must be addressed in the application.

- How the project related to one or more of the Objects of Kiwanis
- The impact upon the local area of Special Olympics
- How the Club/Division will be involved
- The impact upon the community
- The long range plan of this project
- The amount of funding required

The Selection Committee is made up of the K-Team's advisory staff, and does not meet on a regular basis. Applications will be reviewed on an "as needed" basis.
